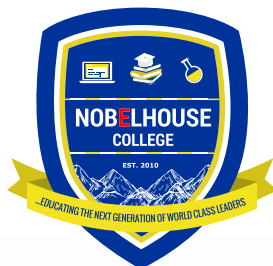

To be an esteemed international school in Nigeria, educating the next generation of world- class leaders.

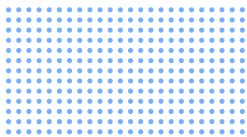
MISSION STATEMENT

THE WHOLE EXPERIENCE



LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

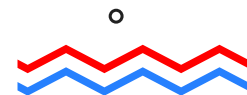
BOARDING
